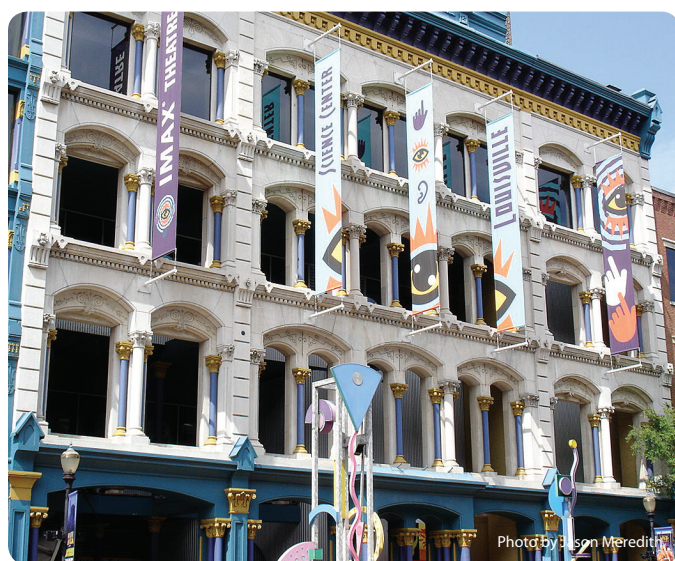
Families will stay overnight at these facilities and enjoy a one-of-a-kind camping experience while connecting and spending quality time together as a family.
