



**DISTRICT (5) 4-H HORSE CAMP
APRIL 23, 24 & 25, 2010
CENTRAL KY AG EXPO, LIBERTY, KY**

Join us for the 2010 District (5) 4-H Horse Camp that is a weekend of overnight camping combined with instructional and fun horse activities. All campers must attend scheduled activities.

ASTM/SEI CERTIFIED HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR EVERY CAMPER WHO BRINGS A HORSE AND MUST BE WORN WHENEVER RIDING.

***WHO CAN ATTEND:** Campers who are at least 9 years old as of January 1 of the current year and be enrolled in their county 4-H horse program.

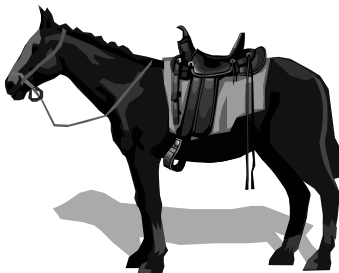
*** COST: \$50/camper with (1) horse.** This includes all clinic fees, a camp t-shirt and (1) bag of shavings. **Youth may bring (1) additional horse for \$25 to include stall fee & (1) bag of shavings.** Participants must stay in respective riding discipline (no crossing disciplines with extra horse) & can use only one horse per class. Additional camp t-shirts can be purchased for approx \$10 each with orders prepaid by the registration deadline. **Campers are to provide their own meals.** A final activity schedule will be provided to all participants.

*** PARENTS: It is strongly recommended that parents attend along with campers.**

*** REG. DEADLINE:** All forms must be **completed** and **fees paid** by the **March 23rd District 5 Horse Council Meeting**. Registration forms & rules can also be found on the District (5) Horse website at (www.hardinext.org).

***SUPERVISION: Each county must have one adult per (4) campers registered to attend.** Due to the *Youth Protection Standards Policy*, all **adults** (including leaders) **must have completed a background check** prior to the registration deadline. Check with your 4-H youth/development agent.

***LEADERS= RESPONSIBILITY:** Stay with assigned 4-H members during all class periods. Maintain full control of youth. Excessive misbehavior **will not** be tolerated. Otherwise parents will be notified to come and pick up camper.



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***LOCATION:** Central KY Ag Expo Center in Liberty, KY / Casey County – located on Hwy 127 approximately 25 minutes south of Danville or 25 minutes North from the Russell Springs Exit on the Cumberland Parkway

***ARRIVAL :** Campers may begin arriving after 6:00 p.m. **(EST)**, Friday afternoon with check-in between 6:00 - 8:00 p.m **(EST)**. T-shirts and stall assignments will be distributed at check-in.

*** SCHEDULE:** Activities begin at 8:00 p.m. Friday and end at 5:00 p.m. Sunday. **There will be no horseback riding on Friday.** On Saturday and Sunday there will be riding and non-riding clinics. A final schedule will be provided to all youth.

***STALLS:** All stalls will be pre-assigned. Extra shavings will be available on site.

***SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS:** **Campers must sleep in assigned areas** and bring suitable (rough camping) sleeping gear such as tents or sleep in trailers. There are RV hookups available for \$15 per night and horse trailers will be ask to park in designated area. **Fees are paid at time of check-in.**

***NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST & CVI** (health paper): Is required for all horses and will be checked upon arrival.
