

- Spoke with Christy today (May 18, 2010) at the Ag Expo:
 1. They plan to work on W/R ring on Wednesday – fence & gazebo is still there & their PA is okay, they just need to get the surface of the ring prepared
 2. RV's are a GO with electric! Don't everyone jump at once. Apparently things are in good shape on that end so YES we will allow for RV's as before \$15 per night – pay as you arrive at the grounds – please check or correct currency – no large bills
 3. Portable toilets – (2) will be placed on the south end of Barn B & (4) will be placed in the RV section – Bathrooms & showers should be okay – may or may not have A/C – but everything should be okay on upper B/R at front concessions
 4. Concessions will be open for B-fast etc on Sat & Sunday – As Most of you know the other places are as follows:
 - a) McDonalds, Lee's Chicken & Pizza Hut (606) 787-5439 are okay – Emma's Café (606) 787-2641 and Bread of Life (606) 787-6110 is fine
 - b) IGA – will not be open while we are there
 - c) Gas stations: BP (gas & diesel) & Dairy Mart (no diesel)
 - d) Motel – I am staying at Cumberland Lodge (270) 866-4208 at Russell Springs & they have rooms available
- On the Day of the Show – **Check-In begins at 8 am EST & Show Starts at 9:00 am EST** – Should people arrive the night before & want their packets that is fine – Patterns are not posted till the day of the show
- On Saturday the ring will be (1) size for contest then divided in two for performance classes on Sunday – There is **NO PRACTICE the day of the show – should exhibitors ride in ring the night before a parent or leader must be with them** – At this point I am not sure about the Sand Pit area
- **Body Condition Scoring** – will be done prior to showmanship – I anticipate this to take place near the washrack area prior to Showmanship – like pony measurements – ALL HORSES MUST be approved by Dr. Fernanda Camargo who is scheduled to be at our show both days – horses must have a score or 4 or higher
